Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim raised by petitioner is similar to the one raised in **CWP-4473 of 2017 decided on 23.04.2024** titled '**Naresh Kumar and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**' and the present writ is for the service rendered against Aided post teacher which has been taken to be a valid serving for computing the qualifying services, and therefore, the petitioner is also entitled for the benefit of the service rendered in the aided institution so as to compute the pensionary benefits admissible to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the claim in the representation dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-9) and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.

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Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 20.11.2024 (Annexure P-9), has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
