JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 10.01.2024 (Annexure P-9) whereby Senior Superintendent of Police, Khanna has dismissed him from service.

2. Mr. Deepak Arora, Advocate submits that petitioner has been isolated and discriminated by impugned order. The similarly situated employees have not been terminated, despite their conviction by trial Court.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service and submits that petitioner has filed an appeal before Appellate Authority against impugned order, thus, instant petition is not maintainable.

5. Faced with this, Mr. Deepak Arora, Advocate submits that he does not press his main prayer, however, Appellate Authority may be directed to decide his appeal expeditiously.

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6. In the wake of statement of both sides, petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with a direction to Appellate Authority to decide petitioner’s appeal expeditiously and preferably within 3 months from today.
