1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*mandamus*' directing respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5.

1.1 A further prayer is also made for issuance of directions to respondent No. 2-the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to decide the representation dated 03.12.2024 (Annexure P-1), given by the petitioners with regard to the above, in accordance with law and within a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Having received advance copy of the petition, Mr. Davinder Bir Singh, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.



- 1 to 3.
4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, issuance of notice to the private respondents No. 4 and 5 is dispensed with as it would unnecessarily delay the proceedings.
5. Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh, has submitted that the representation of the petitioners, dated 03.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) would be enquired into and proper action, if required, shall be taken within a period of 04 weeks from today.
6. Keeping in view the statement given by learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
7. The State shall remain bound by its statement given in Court today.
8. Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
