1. By this common order, the above-said applications are disposed of as issues involved and prayer sought in all the applications are common. For the sake of convenience and with the consent of parties, the facts are borrowed from **ARB-615-2024.**

2. The applicant through instant application under Section 29-A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 read with Section 151 C.P.C. is seeking extension of mandate of Arbitrator appointed by this Court.
3. Notice of the application.
4. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana and Mr. P.S. Rana, Advocate who on advance notice are present in Court, accept notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and respondent Nos. 2 to 5 respectively and waive service.
5. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.
6. Learned counsel for the respective respondents submit that they have no objection if instant application is allowed and mandate of Arbitrator is extended for a further period of 6 months from today.
7. This Court vide order dated 19.04.2022 passed in CM-5633-2022 in CWP-3191-2022 appointed Mr. Justice Jasbir Singh, former Judge of this Court as a sole Arbitrator to resolve the dispute between the parties.
8. In the wake of statement of both sides and for the reasons assigned in the application, the same is allowed. The mandate of Arbitrator is extended for 6 months from today.
9. Allowed accordingly.
