The instant writ petition has been filed challenging the notice dated 02.12.2024 passed by respondent No.2- Insecticide Inspector, Ludhiana directing the petitioner to stop the distribution, sale or exhibiting for sale and use of insecticides for a period of 30 days.

State Counsel has filed an affidavit of Manjit Singh, Insecticide Inspector, Ludhiana, Department of Agriculture & Farmer's Welfare and has referred to Annexure R-5 dated 12.12.2024, as per which the request of the petitioner to continue with the sale of the insecticides has been allowed. She contends that since the cause in question does not survive any further, the present writ petition has become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute about the permission being granted to him by the respondent-Authorities for the sale of the insecticides, however, he contends that the inquiry/investigation in the matter is still kept open and that he may be granted permission to impugn any further decision, if taken against him by the respondent-Authorities, in accordance with law.

Learned State Counsel has no objection to the said prayer.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous at this stage with the liberty as aforesaid.
