Present fifth petition has been filed under Section 483 read with Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*for short, 'the BNSS'*) for grant of interim bail for a period of 01 month to the petitioner in FIR No.225 dated 14.07.2019 under Sections 302, 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*for short, 'the IPC'*); Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959; registered at Police Station, Asauda, Jhajjar, Haryana on the ground that the wife of petitioner is to undergo surgery of Kidney stone (Cholelithiasis) on 26.12.2024.

2. Allegations are that petitioner along with other co-accused, committed murder of Karambir Singh, brother of the *de facto* complainant-Dalbir.



3. Contends that petitioner's wife is to undergo surgery of Kidney stone and there is no one in the family to take care of his ailing wife.
4. *Per contra*, learned State counsel, on instructions from the quarter concerned, vehemently opposed the prayer on the ground that petitioner has 05 brothers and there is a large family for taking care of the wife of petitioner. Again submitted that petitioner is the main accused and there are serious allegations against him of committing murder of the Karambir.
6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the paper-book.
7. Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has 05 brothers and there is a large family for taking care of his wife, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer.
8. As a result thereof, there is no option except to dismiss the petition.
9. Ordered accordingly.
10. Above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of case, in any manner.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
