1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to count the service rendered by him as Special Police Officer for qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that case of the petitioner is squarely covered by judgment dated 15.02.2018 (Annexure P-5) of this Court in ***Sukhjeet Singh and others v. The State of Punjab, CWP No.9936 of 2017.***

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that in terms of judgment of this Court in ***Sukhjeet Singh (supra)***, the respondent-authorities in the case of various officials have considered his claim and passed orders. He further asserts that appropriate authority would consider case of the petitioner in terms of judgment of this



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Court in *Sukhjeet Singh (supra)* and pass an appropriate order within three months from today.

4. In the wake of statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition stands disposed of.
