Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for the grant of benefit of the judgment in **Sunil Kumar Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others 2019(2) S.C.T. 735** so as to grant him the benefit of service rendered by the petitioner in an aided institution while computing the qualifying service for the grant of pensionary benefits, which benefit is not being granted by the respondents to the petitioner though, the same benefit has already been granted to the similarly situated employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 19.11.2024 (Annexure P/11) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.
