1. In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the father of the petitioner passed away on 03.04.2021 and the petitioner who is fully eligible for the grant of companionate appointment, her claim is not being considered.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents be directed to decide the claim of the petitioner for the grant of compassionate appointment forthwith. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition is also being raised in the legal notice dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P-6).

Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 09.08.2024 (Annexure P-6) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
