Petitioner-Bhupinder Singh has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for setting aside order dated 02.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) vide which his bail order has been cancelled by Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, and the bail bonds/surety bonds are forfeited to the State, on account of his non appearance, on one date in FIR No.66 registered under Sections 307, 323, 34 and 120-B of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, at Police Station Focal Point Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner referred to the impugned order dated 02.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) when he was marked absent and his arrest warrants were issued. There was no intentional absence on his part. He could not appear in the Court as petitioner is driver by profession and he was out of station, thus could not reach on time. He is ready to abide by the terms and conditions imposed by this Court. Hence the present petition.



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4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl.A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State.

5. I have considered the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner. In the case in hand, petitioner missed one date on 02.12.2024, as a result, his arrest warrants have been issued for 12.12.2024. Petitioner has approached this Court without any delay. He should have filed application seeking exemption of personal appearance which he failed.

6. However, taking a lenient view, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within 10 days from today and be released on bail to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate subject to the deposit of Rs.15,000/- with District Legal Services Authority, Ludhiana, failing which trial Court may proceed as per law.

7. Petition is accordingly allowed.
