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she has committed suicide in the house of the complainant and there is no allegation which would remotely suggest that the petitioner has played any role to abet the deceased to commit suicide. All the other accused have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by the learned Sessions Judge (Fast Track Court), Ferozepur.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl.A.G., Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from ASI Sukhbir Singh, submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation in terms of order dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) passed by this Court and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Keeping in view the ratio of law enunciated by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar (2014) 8 SCC 273*, *Arnab Manoranjan Goswami v. State of Maharashtra (2021) 2 SCC 427*, *Satender Kumar Antil v. CBI (2022) 10 SCC 51*, *Siddharam Satlingappa Mhetre v. State of Maharashtra & Ors. 2010 SCC OnLine SC 1375* and *Shri Gurbaksh Singh Sibbia V. State of Punjab (1980) 2 SCC 565* and the fact that the order dated 29.10.2024 vide which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person is set aside vide order passed on even date by this Court in CRM-M-62631-2024, the present petition is disposed of and the petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when required and shall cooperate with the Investigating/Arresting Officer and abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482 (2) of BNSS (earlier 438 (2) Cr.P.C.).



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Nothing observed hereinabove shall be construed as expression of opinion of this Court on merits of the case and the trial Court shall proceed without being prejudiced by observations of this Court.
