Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the employees junior to the petitioner have been promoted as Panchayat Officer without considering the claim of the petitioner and therefore, the petitioner is entitled for promoting to the post of Panchayat Officer with effect from the date when his juniors had been promoted.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has already raised the said claim in the representations dated 03.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) and 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-6), which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in

case, the representations dated 03.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) and 12.06.2024 (Annexure P-6), have been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same are still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
