1. Notice of motion.
2. Mr. Saurabh Kapoor, Addl. A.G., Punjab and Ms. Armaan Sagar, Advocate accept notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1 to 3 and 4,5 respectively.
3. The grievance of the petitioner is that the appeal is pending for the decision since long before the Authorities and the contract period is of one year and for the last several dates the case has not been finally heard.
4. Learned State counsel has informed that the next date of hearing of the appeal is 24.12.2024 and he assures the Court that the appeal would be finally decided on the date fixed.
5. Learned counsel for respondents No. 4 and 5 submits that they have filed reply and they should be given fair opportunity of hearing.

6. It is made clear that the Appellate Authority shall decide the appeal positively on the date fixed i.e. 24.12.2024. For the purpose of personal hearing, counsels be given time for arguing their cases without being interfered by one another. The Appellate Authority shall make sure that the arguments of both the sides be recorded and written submissions may also be accepted, if required, thereupon, a speaking order shall be passed within three working days thereafter. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of.
