The petitioner herein is a minor girl aged about 11 years, who unfortunately lost her parents. As per case of the petitioner her maternal uncle Jatinder Singh has been appointed as guardian by the Court of competent jurisdiction vide order dated 28.07.2023 (Annexure P-1). He is now residing in England (UK). He has authorized his mother (petitioner's maternal grandmother) to apply for the passport.

Through this writ petition the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ directing the respondents to re-issue the passport.

Learned counsel representing the respondents has brought to the notice of the Court that there are multiple errors in the petitioner's application including the error while recording the name of her parents.

At this stage, learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition in order to apply afresh

for issuance of passport with better particulars.

Learned counsel representing the respondents has no-objection.
Hence, the instant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
