1. Learned counsel submits that the mother of the petitioner, who was working as an Assistant in the respondent-Department, had unfortunately passed away on 26.11.2018, at the age of 50, at which time, he was merely 16 years old, and on attaining the age of majority in September, 2021, had approached respondent No.3 for considering his claim qua compassionate appointment under the Haryana Civil Services (Compassionate Financial Assistance or Appointment) Rules, 2019, with regard to which even a legal notice dated 30.07.2024 (Annexure P-5) has been served upon the respondents, but the same has yet not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions from the petitioner prays that a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Vibha Tewari, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 30.07.2024 (Annexure P-5) within 03 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to his and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
