SANJIV BERRY, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for directing the respondents to find out the whereabouts of the husband of the petitioner namely Lance Naik Bohara Singh No.4495674M of 1st BN, The Sikh Light Infantry as he is not traceable since 22.07.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner had moved the representation dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondents No.2 and 3 i.e. Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector -9, Chandigarh and Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar respectively, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar,



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to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 7. Disposed of.
