1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that claim raised in the present petition is covered by the decision of this Court in **CWP No.19509 of 2020 decided on 29.11.2024 titled 'Indu Bala Vs. State of Punjab and others'** and respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioners in terms of the said judgment with regard to the eligibility and the grant of marks for the experience as being claimed by the petitioners for correctly evaluating their claim.

Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file appropriate representation with the respondents.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
