Report of the Warrant Officer (dated 13.12.2024) is already available on the file wherein he has categorically mentioned that respondent No.7, who had been brought to the Police Station, had made a *Whatsapp* video call to the detenue and respondent No.5 and the detenue had stated that she had married respondent No.5 on 16.11.2024 and she had been living with him happily and without any pressure, at Delhi.

In view of the above-discussed contents of the Report, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that the petitioners intend to avail the appropriate and efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to them under law, to seek the redressal of their grievance, as set-forth in this petition.

4. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
