This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNS) for issuance of appropriate order or direction to the official respondents to comply with the orders dated 31.08.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed in the petition under Section 175 (3) of BNSS (Annexure P-2) filed at the behest of petitioner No. 2 and submit the complete investigation report before the learned trial court, which is being delayed at the instance of the police on account of the influence of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the official respondents till date has not complied with the order dated 31.08.2024 passed by the Trial Court, moreso, investigating agency is taking dates time and again for furnishing reports.



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Learned State Counsel undertakes before this Court that needful be done on the next date of hearing i.e. fixed as 24.12.2024 without any further delay.

Learned counsel for the respondent at this stage opposes the prayer and submits that the process is an abuse to process of law and jurisdiction of this Court is being misused.

In light of the submissions made by learned State Counsel, counsel for the petitioner does not inclined to press this petition any further.

Hence, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous at this stage.
