



papers by one Advocate, namely, Mr. Milap Singh Bhatti, at the time of filing of above mentioned civil suit, were misused by the advocate later on, in connivance with respondent Nos.7 and 8 and Patwari, Tehsil Ajnala. Thereafter, one FIR bearing No.15 of 2020 under Sections 420/120-B of IPC was registered against the Advocate Mr. Milap Singh Bhatti. Petitioner Nos.1 and 2 also filed civil suit bearing No.CS-54 of 2023 against said advocate for declaring them as owner of the land, which is still pending. As such, due to this dispute, private respondents started threatening the petitioners either to withdraw said civil suit or they will kill them. Learned counsel further submits that on 03.04.2023 at 9:30 AM, private respondents started quarrelling with petitioner Nos.1 and 2 on the pretext of drain slab and gave beatings to them and their family and damaged their shop with their respective weapons and stolen an amount of Rs.50,000/-. Thereafter the complaint dated 03.04.2024 was moved to respondent No.6-SHO, PS Ajnala by petitioner No.1 against private respondents. Thereafter again on 04.04.2023, private respondents launched brutal attack on petitioner No.1 and gave beatings to him and his daughter-in-law, who came in between to rescue him, with their respective weapons. In the meantime, several FIRs and complaints were filed, but to no effect. Petitioner No.1 has again moved applications dated 06.08.2024 (Annexure P-8) to respondent No.4 and dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-10) to respondent No.5 seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent Nos.4 and 5 to consider and decide the representations dated 06.08.2024 (Annexure P-8) and dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-10) submitted by petitioner No.1 in a

time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.
5. Mr. Subhash Godara, Addl. A.G., Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.4 and 5 to consider and decide the representations dated 06.08.2024 (Annexure P-8) and dated 23.10.2024 (Annexure P-10) submitted by petitioner No.1 and take appropriate steps including grant of any protection to the petitioners in view of the apprehension, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
