Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has already raised the said claim in the representations dated 18.11.2024 (Annexure P-4) and 26.11.2024 (Annexure P-5), which are still pending consideration with the respondents and the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.
