AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Tejbir Singh Deol has filed present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect life and liberty of petitioner and his family members who are receiving threatening calls from unidentified persons at the instance of respondent No.5 or any other direction which the Court may deem fit in the given facts and circumstances of the case.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner pointed out that there is a dispute regarding property of petitioner's father with respondent No.5 who is second wife of his father. Earlier, he had filed writ in the nature of mandamus seeking protection of life and liberty bearing CRWP-11701-2022, decided on 11.12.2023 (Annexure P-2), vide which 'petitioner was given liberty to approach competent authorities of the State, in case there is any threat perception as detailed out in the petition, arises again in future, which shall be looked into in accordance with law'.

3. Now petitioner has filed representation to Senior

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Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur dated 27.07.2024 (Annexure P-3), another representation to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur dated Nil (Annexure P-4) and representation to D.I.G., Ferozepur dated 28.11.2024 (Annexure P-5) but no appropriate step has been taken.

4. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. As per order dated 11.12.2023 passed in CRWP No.11701 of 2022 by the Coordinate Bench (Annexure P-2), direction is already given to the State authorities to protect life and liberty of petitioner and his family members, considering threat perception. Therefore, official respondents No.2 to 4 are bound to consider the representations in the light of aforesaid direction.

Present petition is disposed of with the direction to approach the competent authority seeking appropriate relief and in return the official respondents are also bound to consider and dispose of the said representations as per law.
