SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Disposed of with liberty to avail the necessary remedies but at the appropriate stage. However, the respondents concerned are directed, that as and when Municipal Bodies' elections are conducted to the Municipal Corporation(s)/council(s) concerned, thereupon the respondents concerned, shall ensure that complete compliance becomes made to the guidelines issued by the State Election Commission, Punjab, relating to the makings of Videography(ies) of the entire election process, including voting inside the polling booths and the activities outside the polling centres, besides qua the process relating to the counting of votes and also the ferrying of ballot boxes to the strong room(s) concerned.
2. The Chief Secretary, Government of Punjab, is directed to circulate this order to all the Returning Officers concerned.
3. The State Election Commission concerned, is also directed to deploy sufficient police personel, inside and outside the polling booths as well as in the offices' of the Returning Officers concerned.
