By way of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to protect the life and liberty and property of the petitioner and his family members from private respondents No. 6 to 8; further direction in the nature of mandamus to the official respondents to cancel the temporary release of respondents No. 6 to 8 and a further direction that respondents No. 6 to 8 be not released temporarily.

2. Heard.

3. At the very out set, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he will be pressing the instant petition only qua relief seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that so far as the other reliefs qua parole of respondents No. 6 to 8 is



concerned, he does not press the same in the preset petition and prays for liberty to seek separate remedy, if so required, in accordance with the law.

5. Accordingly, instant petition qua parole of respondents No. 6 to 8, stands dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.

6. It is, *inter alia*, submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that apprehending danger to his life and liberty, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 18.09.2024 (Annexure P-10), to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, Punjab, but till date no action on the said representation has been taken.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

8. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

9. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 5 and submits that the aforesaid representation shall be considered and disposed of expeditiously.

10. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 4-Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District

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Jalandhar, Punjab, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 18.09.2024 (Annexure P-10), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

11. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.

12. Disposed of.
