Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's daily wage service has not been taken into account as qualifying service while computing her pensionary benefits by the respondents hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to grant the petitioner the benefit of the judgment of this Court in **CWP-10238-2017 titled as Jeewan Lata vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 10.05.2019.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in case, the benefit of the said judgment is given to the petitioner, the petitioner will also be entitled for the benefit of judgment of this Court in **CWP-2371-2010 Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 08.12.2023 (Annexure P/6) with the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and



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the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Satnam Preet Singh Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case, representation dated 08.12.2023 (Annexure P/6) has been filed by the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which order will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage.
