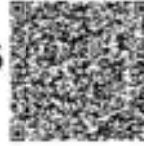

This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 the constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus by way of issuing directions to the respondent No.2 & 3 to produce the Detenue namely Lovepreet Kaur daughter of Jaswant Singh resident of Vill. Bhambri, Fatehgarh Sahib, before this Court from the illegal detention and custody from the hands of respondents No. 4 & 5, who has detained the detenue against her rights and wishes.

On the last date Warrant Officer was appointed for conducting the enquiry who today has submitted his report which is taken on record and is reproduced below :-

'In compliance with the order dated 13.12.2024 passed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sandeep Moudgil undersigned was appointed as Warrant Officer in the above noted case on 13.12..2024.



At the very outset learned counsel for the petitioner told undersigned that the search is to be conducted on 14.12.2024. I left Chandigarh at 12.10 pm on 14.12.2024 alongwith petitioner and reached Police Station Doraha District Khanna at 01.40 pm. SI/SHO Rao Varinder Singh met there. After disclosing my identity and purpose of visit, I ask him to provide police protection to search the detenue Loverpreet Kaur at the premises of respondent No. 5.

I along with petitioner and police party reached premises of respondent No. 5. Detenue was found present there. On my asking she got recorded her statement (Annexure R-1) to the effect that she is living there since 05.09.2024. Her date of birth is 05.12.2006. She also handed over me the copy of matriculation certificate (Annexure R-2). She further stated that her mother got registered FIR No. 20 dated 25.03.2024 u/s 363/366-A IPC against Jaspreet Singh. Her statement was recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate. She said that she does not want to go at her parent's house. She said that she will go with the petitioner Jaspreet Singh without any pressure and fear.

Mrs. Anita Sharma, Incharge, Heavenly Angles Children Home, Doraha handed over the copy of order of CWC, Fatehgarh Sahib dated 05.09.2024 (Annexure R-3) vide which detenue Loverpreet Kaur had been sent to Heavenly Angles Children Home, Doraha.

Detenue Loverpreet Kaur was handed over to petitioner Jaspreet Singh vide farad hawargi (Annexure R-4)

DD Entry No. 26 dated 14.12.2024 made by the concerned police station is at Annexure R-5.

I left for Chandigarh at 5.30 pm on 14.12.2024.'

It is evident from the perusal of the report that custody of

the alleged detainee namely Lovepreet Kaur has been handed over back to the petitioner.

In light of the above, counsel for the petitioner does not wish to press this petition any further, therefore, pray for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Allowed as prayed for.
