1. Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No. 1 to 4 to initiate action against respondents No. 5 and 6 and concerned officials of Nagar Panchayat Khamanon, who illegally and arbitrarily demolished the portion/area of house of petitioner and thereafter took possession thereof.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant civil writ petition with liberty to avail other remedies, as available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
