1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to decide the stay application filed by the petitioner in ROR No. 18 of 2024-2025 titled as Roop Chand Versus Sukki and others (Annexure P-11), which is pending before the learned Financial Commissioner, Faridabad, Haryana, in expeditious manner .
2. On advance service of copy of petition, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondent-State.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Kamal, Clerk-FCR, submits that the stay application as well as the revision petition filed by the petitioner is pending before the learned Financial Commissioner for 19.12.2024. She further submits that in all probability, the stay application filed by the petitioner along with the revision petition will be decided by the Financial Commissioner on the date already fixed i.e. 19.12.2024 and not in any case beyond a period of four weeks thereafter.



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4. In view of the aforesaid statements made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Financial Commissioner to decide the stay application filed by the petitioner along with revision petition on the date already fixed, i.e. 19.12.2024, and not in any case, beyond the period of four weeks thereafter. It is further directed that till the time the stay application is finally decided, the parties shall maintain status quo, as existing today.
5. It is also made clear that the learned Financial Commissioner shall decide the stay application and/or the revision petition strictly in accordance with law, without being influenced by anything observed hereinabove or by the fact that vide this order, the status quo has been granted.
6. This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
