This is a petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 07.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) submitted before respondent No.2 against the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioner, feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No.4 to 7 and apprehending threat to her life and liberty, had moved the representation dated 07.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation dated 07.12.2024



(Annexure P-4) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 07.12.2024 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 7. Disposed of.
