1. The prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent Nos.3 and 4 to provide the petitioner job on compassionate ground on account of death of his father during service.
2. The petitioner has stated that though he had applied for appointment on compassionate ground in the year, 2011, however, his claim has not been considered, while reference is made to certain information that was received by the petitioner as stated in para 9 of the petition, with regard to the members of families of other similarly situated employees, who have been granted the Ex-gratia amounts, however, in his legal notice dated 02.02.2024, these facts were not mentioned. Faced with this, learned counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition to enable him to file a detailed representation/serve a legal notice, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.
3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn. In case representation/legal notice are submitted within a period of 4 weeks, the same shall be decided in accordance with law, expeditiously.
