Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there are posts which are lying vacant in the promotional cadre of Agriculture Officer qua which claim has been made by the petitioners but, the respondents are not considering the claim of the petitioners despite the fact that as per the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **Dr. Sandhya Jain Vs. Dr. Subhash Garg, 2000 AIR (SC) 29, decided on 15.10.1999**, read with the instructions issued by the State, the petitioners are entitled for promotion.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners intend to file a detailed representation with the respondents raising the same claim and the respondents be directed to decide the same in an appropriate manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in case, any representation has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
