1. Petitioner Hans Raj has filed criminal writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking direction in the nature of Mandamus to official respondents to consider complaint/representation sent by petitioner for taking appropriate legal action and to protect life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 9. Alongwith petition, petitioner has annexed copy of complaint filed to SHO, Police Station Focal Point, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-3) and Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-5). Said complaints were also sent through e-mail for taking legal action and to protect his life and liberty but no action has been taken.

2. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab appeared on behalf of official respondents No. 1 to 4.

3. Considering the aforesaid factual position, official respondents No. 2 to 4 are directed to consider aforesaid complaints/representations within a period of three weeks from today and in the meantime, if there is any threat perception, then appropriate steps be also taken.

With aforesaid direction, present petition is accordingly,
disposed of.

4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands
disposed of accordingly.
