This is a petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directions to respondents No. 2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 6 to 20.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, *inter alia*, contends that the petitioners, feeling aggrieved by the act and conduct of private respondents No. 6 to 20 and apprehending threats to their life and liberty had moved the representations, the latest being the representation dated 13.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2,3 and 5 respectively, but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No.5 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation dated 13.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance

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- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Singh Bhatta, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 5 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.5- The Police Commissionerate, District Administrative Complex, Amritsar, Punjab, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 13.12.2024 (Annexure P-1) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner so as to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and if needed, provide requisite protection to their life and liberty.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners.
- 7. Disposed of.
