JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release his service benefits.

2. The petitioner joined Punjab Police on 24.03.1976. He left for USA in 1990. He sought ex-India leave for a period from 27.04.1990 to 25.07.1990. He did not return on the expiry of aforesaid period. He was served notice which culminated in his termination. He preferred neither appeal nor availed any other remedy against the order of dismissal. He served legal notice dated 16.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) upon respondent seeking release of his terminal/service benefits. The respondent in its reply has informed the petitioner that he has not submitted requisite documents.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and waives service.
5. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.
6. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab submits that petitioner is not entitled to pension, however, Competent Authority would release all other benefits to which he is entitled. He may be directed to submit requisite documents.
7. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to petitioner to submit requisite documents with respect to his pending dues. The Competent Authority would do the needful within 3 months from the date of submitting requisite documents.
8. It is hereby made clear that this order would not entitle the petitioner to those benefits to which he is not otherwise entitled.
