1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is working on the post of Junior Engineer and the respondent-Institute has already regularized the services of certain Computer Teachers and non-teaching Staff but the said benefit has not been given to the Junior Engineers, who are also entitled for regularization of their services. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that law on the said issue has already been decided by this Court while passing order in CWP No. 7764 of 2015 titled as **Balbir Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on 04.12.2018 which judgment has already been upheld by the Division Bench in LPA No. 706 of 2020.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 02.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a



direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Anupam Singla, Advocate and Mr. Lalit Goyal, Advocate appears on behalf of respondent No. 3.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that in case, the legal notice dated 02.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

7. Ordered accordingly.
