HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that benefit of salary in terms of the 6th Pay Commission starting from July 2021 to September 2022 has not been paid to the petitioners and that too without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondents had taken a decision to release the arrears within a period of next five years by citing paucity of funds which plea has already been rejected by this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.11252 of 2023 titled as Jaspreet Rahal vs. Punjabi University, Patiala and others, decided on 25.11.2024*** hence, respondents are liable to be directed to release the arrears admissible to the petitioners forthwith.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the

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petitioners in the legal notice dated 04.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. H.S. Batth, Advocate, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the legal notice dated 04.10.2024 (Annexure P-5) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
