1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to issue a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate action on the complaint dated 02.05.2024 against the respondents No.4 and 5.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Ambala and he shall be satisfied at this stage, if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rajinder Kumar Banku, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.



5. In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Ambala, to look into representation dated 02.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action within a period of two weeks, in accordance with law.
