Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari to set aside order dated 05.12.2024 (Annexure P-13) passed by the learned Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Faridabad and order dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-14) passed by the learned Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage in case the appeal bearing No.68/2024-25 dated 04.12.2024, filed on behalf of respondent No.4 (Tara Chand), pending before the learned Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Faridabad, is ordered to be decided in a time bound manner.

3. At this stage, Mr. Randhir Singh, Additional Advocate General,

Haryana, appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him, and submits that the Commissioner, Faridabad Range, Faridabad/competent authority shall take decision either way, on the aforesaid pending appeal bearing No.68/2024-25 dated 04.12.2024, expeditiously.

4. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Faridabad/competent authority to consider and decide the appeal, bearing No.68/2024-25 dated 04.12.2024 filed on behalf of respondent No.4 (Tara Chand) by way of passing a speaking order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties, expeditiously and preferably within a period of six months from today.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
