4. Heard.
5. The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to register the sale certificate after due verification of the relevant facts, expeditiously preferably within a period of one month. In the event of the sale

certificate being found to be defective and not fit for registration, respondents No.2 and 3 shall pass a speaking order in that regard.
