The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to decide the application of the petitioner for upgrading the enlistment of petitioner Firm from Class C contractor to Class B contractor without any further delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, recently he has submitted his application/representation dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) to the respondent-authorities but no action has been taken by them till date.

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Mr. Anil Kumar Sharma, Senior Panel Counsel appear and accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2-Union of India.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.1-Union of India through Head Quarter Chief Engineer Western Command, Chandimandir Cantt, Panchkula is directed to consider and decide the application/representation dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.1-Union of India through Head Quarter Chief Engineer Western Command, Chandimandir Cantt, Panchkula to consider and decide the application/representation dated 19.09.2024 (Annexure P-9) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
