1. This is a Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of directions to the Ist Appellate Court to decide the appeal bearing no.CIS no.CMA/226/2023 titled as “M/s Kew Industries Ltd. vs. M/s Punjab Financial Corporation etc.” filed by the petitioner, expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had filed an appeal against the order dated 11.10.2023 vide which the application filed under Order 39 Rules 1 and 2 CPC was dismissed and in the said case, respondents no.1 and 2 had appeared on 20.12.2023 and respondents no.3 to 6 were proceeded against ex-parte. It is submitted that sufficient number of dates had been taken by the respondents to file reply to the stay application and ultimately the reply was filed on 11.11.2024, on



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which date the case was adjourned to 17.12.2024 for arguments but however, on 17.12.2024, the Presiding Officer was on leave and the case was adjourned to 10.03.2025. In the said circumstances, it is submitted that the Ist Appellate court be directed to decide the said appeal, as expeditiously as possible.

3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present revision petition is disposed of with a direction to the Ist Appellate Court to decide the appeal bearing no.CIS no.CMA/226/2023 titled as “M/s Kew Industries Ltd. vs. M/s Punjab Financial Corporation etc.” filed by the petitioner, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six weeks from 10.03.2025.
