The present petition has been filed by an alleged public spirited person assailing the ongoing Municipal Corporations and Municipal Councils elections in the State of Punjab by pointing out various irregularities and illegalities which have crept in the process of elections which according to the petitioner have rendered the entire election process a farce.

After hearing learned counsel for the rival parties, this Court is of the considered opinion that in view of the Constitutional bar contained in Article 243ZG of the Constitution of India and the disputed question(s) of fact having been raised in this petition, this Court refrains from interference and the petitioner is free to avail the remedy of filing Election Petition.
3. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
