In the present petition, the petitioner is claiming the benefit of promotion to the post of Principal under the 1% posts reserved for the physically handicapped (blindness and low vision).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the post in the reserved category of physically handicapped (blindness and low vision) is available but claim of the petitioner has not been considered hence, the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner by passing appropriate speaking order.

3. Learned counsel further submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 15.09.2024 (Annexure P-13), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, that the respondents be directed to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion.

Mr. Swapan Shorey, DAG, Punjab who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that in case, the representation dated 15.09.2024 (Annexure P-13), has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of 08 weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
7. Ordered accordingly.
