1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for quashing of FIR No.18 dated 1.2.2024, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh, on the basis of partial compromise.
2. This Court has already referred the issue to Larger Bench of this Court, which has now been answered and as per the judgment dated 12.11.2024 of the Larger Bench passed in CRM-M-48043-2023, the partial compromise is not permissible under law.
3. In view of the above, the instant petition is **dismissed**, however, the petitioner is at liberty to re-access this Court on the same cause of action in case full and final compromise is entered between the parties concerned.
