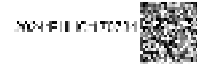

In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the employees namely, Ms. Sapna Sharma as well as one Kamaldeep Kaur are getting higher salary than the petitioner despite the fact that they are junior to the petitioner in the Master's cadre and per the instructions issued by the Government of Punjab, a senior employee, who is getting lesser salary is entitled for step up of his/her pay, which benefit is not being extended to the petitioner and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 15.09.2024 (Annexure P/9), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amar Preet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on



behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case legal notice dated 15.09.2024 (Annexure P/9) has been received from the petitioner, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same will be granted to the petitioner otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
