SHEEL NAGU, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

1. The petitioner Trust has filed this petition seeking direction to the respondents to decide its application dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) praying for increase in intake capacity from 60 to 90 for Veterinary Livestock Development Diploma (VLDD) course for the academic session 2024-25 in the College being run by the petitioner Trust.

2. It is seen from the record that the said application for increase in intake capacity was submitted on 13.11.2024 to respondent No.2.

3. On being asked by the Court, learned senior counsel for the petitioner informs that there is no procedure or instructions, prescribing any time line for making an application for increase in the intake capacity.



4. Be that as it may, since the process of admission to the said VLDD course has already begun and presently, the mop-up round of counseling is ongoing, this Court is of the considered view that the competent authority cannot, in this short period of time, decide the question as to whether the intake capacity qua academic session 2024-25 can be increased or not. However, the petitioner Trust can always pursue the said application for the subsequent academic session 2025-26.

5. With the aforesaid liberty, this petition stands disposed of, without commenting upon merits of the claim of the petitioner.
