Learned counsel representing the passport authority submits that Provisional Police Clearance Certificate qua the petitioner has been issued on 13.12.2024, however, this is subject to police verification report.

Keeping in view the facts of the case it is considered appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition while directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar to personally examine the matter and take appropriate steps in accordance with the law for issuance of Police Clearance Certificate to the petitioner within a period of next 10 days. However, if the SSP concerned decides to refuse the certificate then a speaking order disclosing the reasons for declining to issue the Police Clearance Certificate shall be communicated to the petitioner within a period of one month.

With these observations, the present writ petition is disposed of.
