In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner is 90% disabled and keeping in view the said fact, the petitioner is entitled for being assigned the lighter duty so that the petitioner is able to perform the same keeping in view the disability of the petitioner, however he is currently assigned field work (hard duty).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 04.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Saurabh Girdhar, AAG Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Ashish Yadav, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 to 6 and submits that in case, the representation dated 04.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
