1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had rendered more than three decades of service with the respondents but her services have not been regularized, which is causing prejudice to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the question of law raised in the present writ petition has already been answered by this Court while passing order in ***CWP No.26714 of 2019 titled as Hira Devi and others vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 19.07.2024*** and the respondents be directed to consider the claim of the petitioner in light of the said judgment by passing an appropriate speaking order.

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4. Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate order on the claim of the petitioner for regularization of her services in light of the judgment in *Hira Devi's case (supra)* will be passed by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision any relief is to be extended to the petitioner, the same will be extended, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order to be passed for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for her information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
