1. The prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to grant family pension to the petitioner, in view of Rule 63 (2) of Haryana Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2016, the petitioner being 70% disabled, as per disability certificate dated 22.09.2022, Annexure P-4.

2. Learned counsel would contend that regarding the claim raised in the present petition, a representation/application dated 06.02.2024, Annexure P-5, has been submitted by him, but the same has yet not evoked any response. He thus, at this stage, on instructions from the petitioner, prays that a direction be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Tanisha Peshawaria, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has no objection to the limited prayer made.

5. In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to

consider and decide the representation/application dated 06.02.2024 within a period of 2 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to him and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to his interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioner shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
